

INSTRUMENTAL BALANCE

New members will be placed within the Orchestra Section suitable to their abilities.

Assessment for members to move from the Junior to Intermediate section and from Intermediate to Senior Section will be arranged periodically.

If members of the Senior/Intermediate Section do not keep to the required standard then their membership will be reviewed and they may be moved to the Intermediate/Junior Section or asked to leave.

ATTENDANCE AT REHEARSALS

If a member is unable to attend a rehearsal then the Executive Secretary should be informed by using the absence facility in the website,

If a member misses more than three consecutive rehearsals they may be asked to leave unless they are absent due to illness, holiday or other pre-notified reasons.

ATTENDANCE AT EVENTS

All members are required to attend Orchestra events. If a member is unable to attend the Executive Secretary must be informed as soon as possible using the absence notification process.

BEHAVIOUR

High standards of behaviour are expected at all times to enable all participants to enjoy their music experience, both individually and as members performing together. Unacceptable behaviour will be discussed with parents

UNIFORM and EQUIPMENT

When the orchestras are giving public performances they are required to wear black trousers, black shoes and a polo shirt pertaining to the colour of their section

i.e. Seniors wear black polo shirts, Intermediates wear blue and Juniors wear green.

Polo shirts for the lower sections can be loaned or purchased but Senior section members must purchase their own shirts through CYWO.

MUSIC

Members will be provided with a folder containing music for his/her chosen instrument. This music remains the property of CYWO and is lent to the member for rehearsal purposes.

If a member loses his/her music a charge of £5.00 for each lost piece will be charged to cover the cost of obtaining legitimate replacements i.e. not a photocopy as that breaches copyright laws. The cost may rise if a member loses a music book.

All members are expected to have their own named music stand for rehearsals and events.

FEES

Members are required to pay membership fees as determined and requested by Surrey Arts. Fees are payable at the beginning of each term directly to Surrey Arts.
